



UpSurge hosted **4 Founder Dinners** that connected tech founders across stages to investors and influencers from across the state.

SCALING DEEP

In collaboration with Loam and Code City Strategies, UpSurge supported the **9-month Scaling**Deep pilot for emerging leaders in tech and startups in Baltimore, promoting talent retention, leadership development, and peer support. In November, the program was nominated for the 2024 Technical.ly Awards for Baltimore's Program of the Year for its work with 13 leaders, representing startups (i.e. Apkudo, EcoMap Technologies, and more), industry (i.e. Whiting Turner, Mindgrub), and entrepreneur support organizations (i.e. Loyola's Entrepreneurship Center, Digital Harbor Foundation).

In the fall, UpSurge Baltimore won the SBA's Regional Innovation Cluster Network contract with Maryland Technology Development Corporation (TEDCO). 
